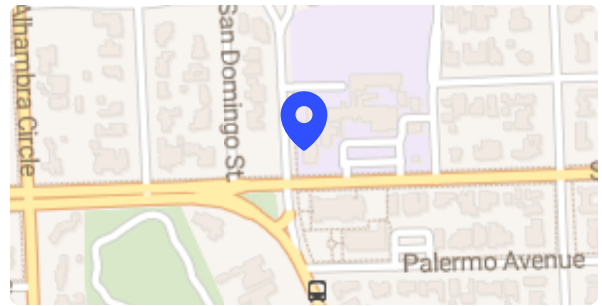
OCT 19, 1929 - SEP 12, 2014

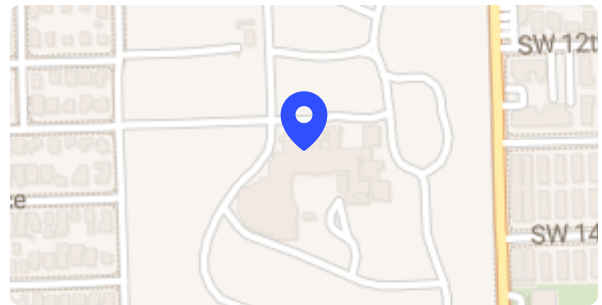
