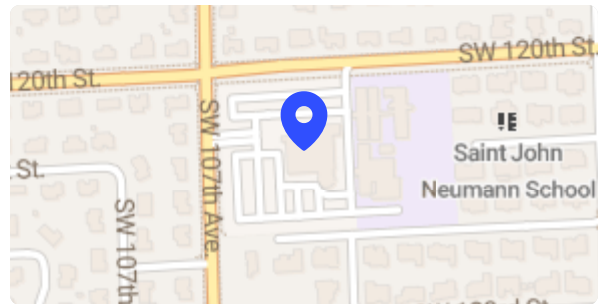

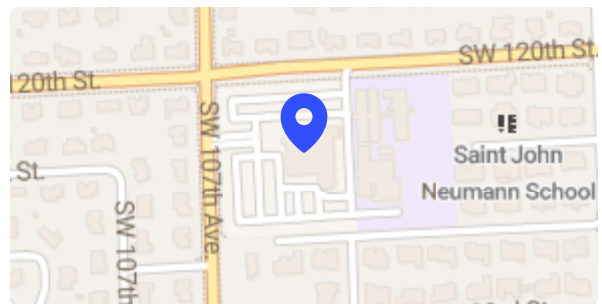


Mass of the Resurrection

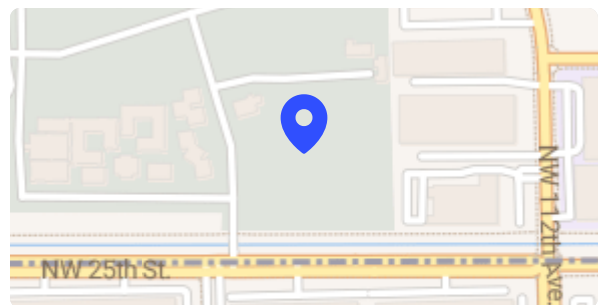
