# Theresa G. Harrington

**T**heresa G. Harrington, 76, passed away in Miami, Florida, on February 9, 2011. She spent her final days in the presence of loving family and friends.

Theresa was born in Brooklyn, New York, on February 10, 1934, to Robert and Irene Giasi. She moved with her family to Tampa and, later, Miami in the mid 1950's. She met her husband, William Harrington, as an employee for the Dade County Zoning Department. They were married October 26, 1957.

Theresa was an active member of St. Timothy's Catholic Church and a dedicated member of their choir. She was also a professional florist and coached her daughters' softball teams. 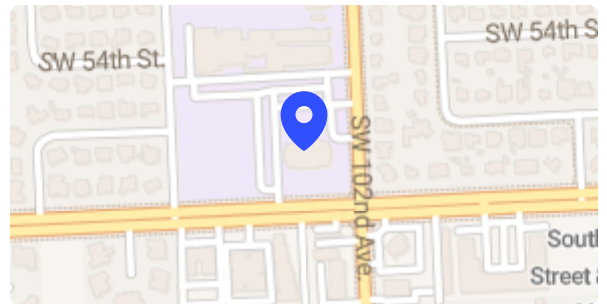

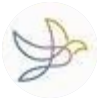

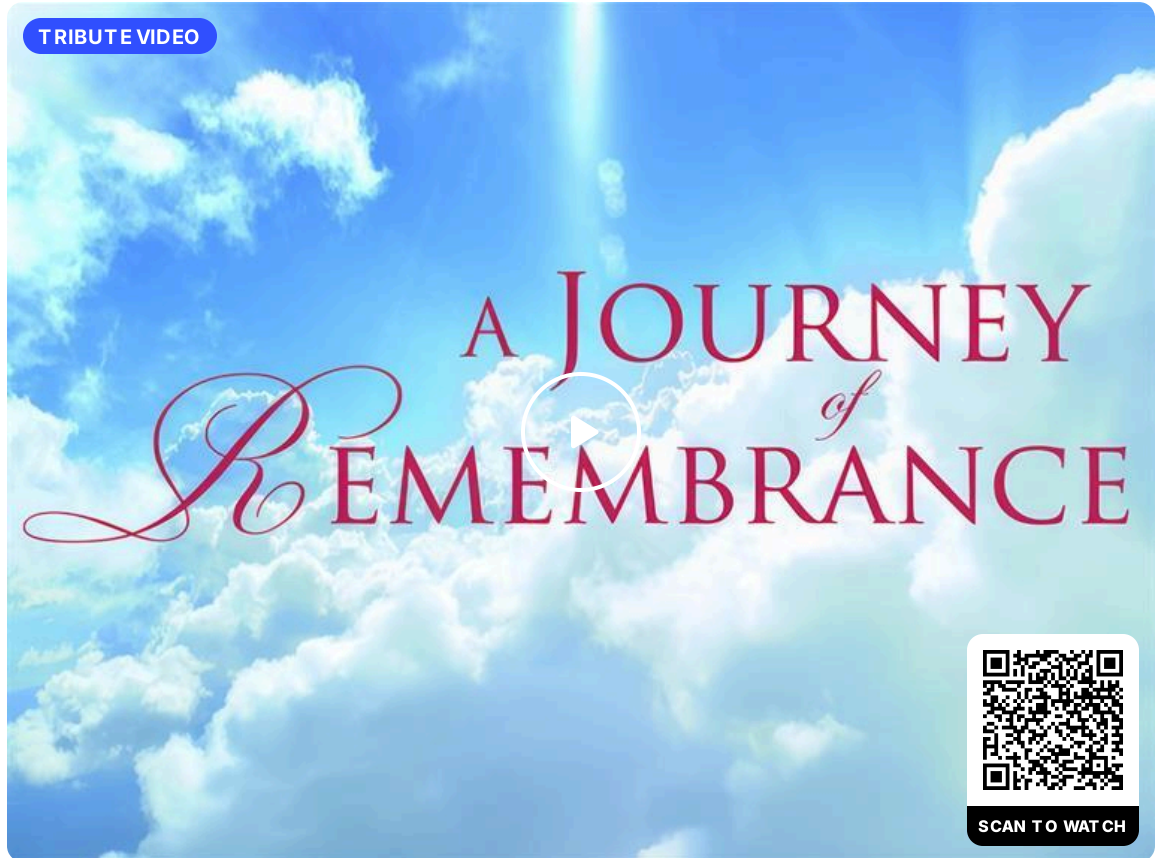
