Janet Elizabeth Kniskern Shrader, 90, passed away peacefully in her sleep on February 19, 2019. She was born in Louisville KY in 1928 to Charles Beckham Kniskern and Mary Elizabeth Kniskern. She had lived in Miami since she was 2 yrs old, moving here with her mother and 2 brothers while her father continued working in Louisville Kentucky for several years during the hard times after the Depression before returning to Miami and his family. She attended Miami High, where she first met her future husband, Clive Shrader. She went on to graduate from the University of Miami where she was a member of Chi Omega sorority and a PKA sweetheart. It was during her college years that she dated Clive. They married in November 1950 and were married for almost 65 years before he passed away in 2015. She and Clive were very involved in the competitive swimming world for years because of their children's participation in the sport, taking active roles in the management of the sport and assisting at swim meets. She was always available for any family member or friend who needed advice, information, or help of any kind. She adored her grandsons and spent lots of time with them taking them on trips and attending all of their sporting events.
