Rachel is preceded in death by her beloved husband of over 70 years Joseph Mervyn Boyett.






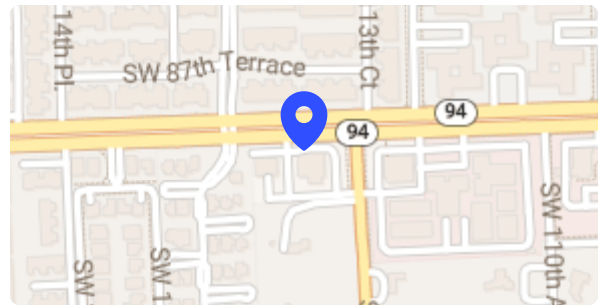

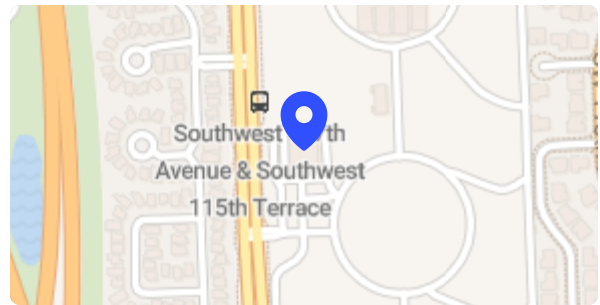

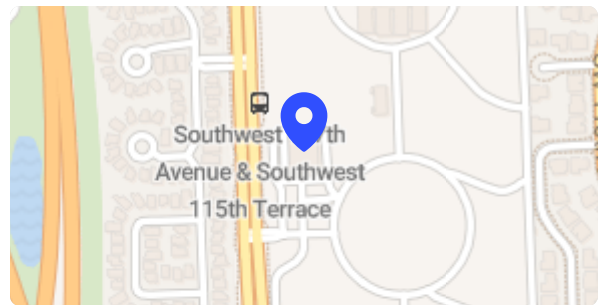
