Rest in Peace, Gerry.




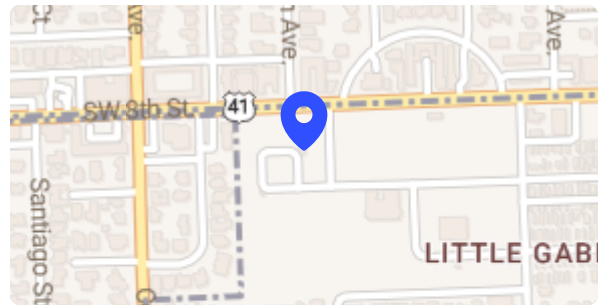

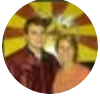
